



# COVID-19 District Plan

## Daily Health Assessments



- Temperature checks administered prior to student entry. Students exhibiting a 100°F temperature or above or other COVID 19 symptoms, will be isolated and examined.
- Students will arrive at the Edgerton campus no earlier than 7:40am each day. The elementary playground and foyer entrances are closed until that time as well.

## Communication About COVID-19 in our School



- Positive tests for COVID 19 will be referred to the Williams County Health Department; communication will be done in partnership with the WCHD and Edgerton
- People shall stay home at least 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND until no fever for 3 days.
- Household members shall stay home to quarantine for 14 days.

## Face Coverings



- Face coverings are Highly Recommended and Encouraged for all students
- All students and coaches shall wear a mask if riding on school transportation
- Staff members will be required to wear a face covering
- School nurses and/or staff who care for students with symptoms must wear PPE

## Health Issues Not Diagnosed as COVID



- Please refer to the Decision Tree for people with COVID19 symptoms
- Students exhibiting any symptoms will be isolated and sent home.
- People shall stay home until no fever for 3 days and/or seen by a health provider.

## Classroom Occupancy



- Likelihood of infection will be decreased with hygiene, cleaning, and safety procedures; however, public places have risk that cannot be eliminated.
- Students will be required to sanitize their hands before and after classes, before and after eating, and after using the restroom.
- Students may bring “clear” water containers.

## Online Learning



- Online learning is available for students of parents who do not choose to send their child to school.
- Deadline for online registration is August 7th @ 3:00pm; applications can be found online or office.
- Assignments are daily and are not Pass/Fail. Minimum of 27.5 hours/week by student is required.
- Online students must complete the semester online.

## Food Service



- Food service in the lunchroom will follow “Dine Safe” orders, similar to restaurants in the county.
- Student lunch room areas will be sanitized between scheduled lunches.
- Social Distancing will be maximized.

## Hand Sanitizing Stations



- Edgerton will provide hand sanitizing stations throughout the building, classroom, and school transportation.
- All students and staff will sanitize hands at the school entrances before entering the facility.
- Students will be required to practice good hand washing and sanitizing throughout the day.

## Transportation



- Parents are required to take child’s temperatures before boarding the bus. Students with temperatures exceeding 100F must be kept home.
- There may be two or three students per seat
- Face coverings will be required for students and drivers while on the bus for every event.
- Students must use hand sanitizer when boarding.

## Recess



- Students will sanitize hands before and after recess,
- Student access to certain pieces of playground equipment may be limited and activities that are “high touch” may be restricted.
- Recess will be more structured to limit the students’ physical contact with others.
- Field trips will be postponed.

## Visitors



- Visitors are discouraged from being in school district facilities during school hours.
- All visitors will be required to wear a face covering when arriving at the campus.
- Safety precautions, such as taking temperatures and completing a screening questionnaire, shall be implemented for all visitors.

## General Notes

- If the county is labeled by the State of Ohio as “orange”, school districts would require face masks to be worn by all students in grades K-12. Students will need to provide their own face covering.
- If the county is labeled by the State of Ohio as “red”, all county district schools would re-implement remote/online learning for all students. Face-to-face students will remain with their teachers.
